Winter Reminders

- Unfortunately, I DO NOT/am incapable of doing snow removal of any type. If you request a service it is up to you to ensure pathways are clear and safe. I will do services as best as I can but if the path to a task is not clear enough, as in potentially dangerous, I will not engage in the service.
- Snow Storms/inclemate weather My current vehicle is not as reliable in such weather however I am looking into getting something different so hopefully by the time such weather hits us I will have a very reliable vehicle. During storms I may need to adjust visit time(s) according to ability but do know I will try my hardest.
- If possible, it is always a good idea to have a backup contact (friend, family, etc) in the case I am not able to push through a storm and make it in a timely manner.
- Sometimes if a storm is incoming and I have multiple visits late at night and early in the morning, I will try to spend the night at one of the stops. If you are ok with me staying overnight at your home (again only if I am already doing a service visit) please let me know and I will add you to the list. This allows me to ensure no delays in visiting your furbabies. These situations are also not charged as overnight visits as it is greatly aiding me.
